# THIRTY YEARS ON — THE SPOHR THEMATIC CATALOGUE

FTER many years of work, Folker Göthel completed his Spohr thematic catalogue in 1977 and it was published by Hans Schneider of Tutzing in 1981 with the title *Thematisch-Bibliographisches Verzeichnis der Werke von Louis Spohr*, a total of 576 pages. With such a large field to cover, it was inevitable that Göthel's research would be subject to errors and omissions though these were comparatively few and most of them have already been picked up.

In one respect, however, the catalogue has quickly fallen out of date and in what, 30 years ago, would have been thought a rather surprising area. Many of the works which Göthel listed as "unveröffentlicht" (unpublished) have appeared in print over the past three decades so we feel it essential to gather together information on these editions.

This list contains only two categories of publication: first editions of previously unpublished compositions and full scores of works which had earlier been printed only in parts or in piano reductions.

We exclude straight reprints of earlier publications as well as modern scholarly critical editions except where these latter fall into our two categories mentioned above. However, an appendix includes two important nineteenth century first editions which escaped Göthel's net.

#### **APPENDIX**

Fantasie and Variations on a Theme of Danzi, Op.81: Edited by Robert Stark; C.F. Schmidt, Heilbronn. Orchestral parts Volume No.92 (1892). Göthel lists Schmidt edition No.90 which is for clarinet and string quartet only as well as the version for clarinet and piano (No.91) but omits any mention of the orchestral parts publication (No.92) which was the first printing of this material. These parts were noted by Stephen K. Johnston in his 1972 dissertation *The Clarinet Concertos of Louis Spohr* (University of Maryland), p.128, where he lists this edition as an arrangement by the editor, Robert Stark, though there is no evidence about this claim in the Schmidt publication.

**Psalm 24, Op.97a:** Adapted into English from the German by William Thomas Freemantle and revised by S.S. Wesley; Novello, Ewer & Co., London. 5057 (c.1874/75). Göthel gives an 1890 German edition by Friedrich Luckhardt of Berlin as the psalm's first publication.
